ORDINANCE # 01-2002

ORDINANCE RELATING TO CHARGING
PROPERTY OWNERS FOR FIRE CALLS

WHEREAS, THE Town Board must provide for fire protection for the Town, pursuant to Section 60.55 (1), Statutes and


WHEREAS, THE Town Board is authorized by Section 60.55 (2), Statutes, to fund the provision of fire protection by charging property owners a fee for the cost of fire calls made to their property;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Town of Otter Creek, Dunn County, Wisconsin ordains as follows:

- Section 1. Owners of real or personal property shall pay the actual cost billed to the Town for fire calls.
- Section 2. The Town Clerk shall mail a statement for the full charge(s) to the owner of the property for which a fire call was made as soon after the fire call as practicable. Unless the fee is paid to the Town Treasure within ninety days after the day the statement was sent by the Clerk, interest shall accrue on the unpaid balance at the rate of 1.5% per month from the date of the original billing. Fire call fees remaining unpaid as of November 1, of the year, shall be collected in any manner authorized by law.
- Section 3. With the enactment of this ordinance, the Town of Otter Creek is repealing any previous ordinances or resolutions in effect in the township.
- Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.


