

Ordinance #0-1-2017

An ordinance requiring Utility Permits for utilities constructed on Town Road right of ways.

The Town Board of the Town of Otter Creek, Dunn County Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

A. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 86.07(2), the Township of Otter Creek shall issue permits for the construction or alteration of utility facilities on Township roads.

B. The Township will use the Wisconsin County Highway Association Utility Policy of 8-21-2012 as a general reference for its utility permit policy, however the Town Board reserves the right to alter this policy as necessary to adapt to special circumstances and to require special conditions for permits.


To offset the costs involved in utility permit review, the following fees are established:

1. First 200 foot segment as measured along the centerline of the highway - \$75.00.
2. Each additional 1,000 foot segment as measured along the centerline of the highway - \$55.00.


This ordinance shall be in force after its passage and publication.




