

R-2-2026 RESOLUTION POSTING WEIGHT LIMITS ON TOWN OF OTTER CREEK ROADS

Whereas:

Section 349.16 of Wisconsin Statutes grants authority to townships to impose seasonal limits on vehicle weights and to impose limits due to weakness of the road bed due to deterioration.

Whereas: Many roads in the Town of Otter Creek are constructed over a sand base that is inadequate to support heavy traffic.

Whereas: Many roads cross wetlands and waterways and the base for these sections of road is composed of muck and peat which is inadequate to support heavy traffic.

Whereas: The thickness of pavement road surfaces in the Township is two inches or less and is inadequate to support heavy vehicles.

Whereas: Many roads in the Township show signs of weakness and deterioration such as cracked pavement, rutted road surfaces and other signs of damage and deterioration.

Therefore be it resolved:

The Township of Otter Creek, Dunn County, Wisconsin shall post maximum weight limits on its roads as follows:

Gross vehicle weight restrictions are 5 ton per axle configuration with a max gross vehicle weight of 25 tons/50,000 pounds.

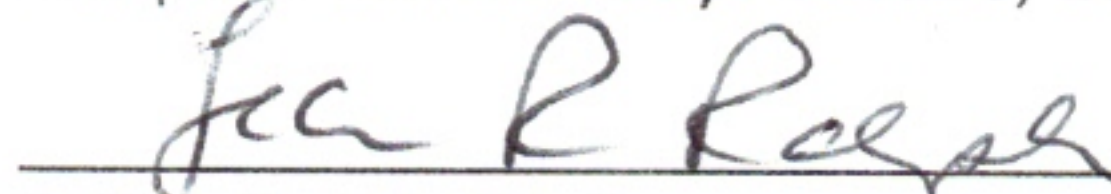
